STOP PRESS: State Liberals Fail to Deliver on Car Park Promise

The NSW Liberal Government has failed to deliver on its promise to start construction this year on 700 new car parking spaces at Edmondson Park Station.

June's State Budget delivered next to nothing for the promised and desperately-needed car park at Edmondson Park Station. This is despite a pre-election promise from Premier Gladys Berejiklian and Member for Holsworthy Melanie Gibbons in January.

This means the commuter car parking crisis at Edmondson Park will continue for years to come. It is cynical, completely unacceptable and I will be demanding answers from the Minister and the Premier. I urge all residents to do the same.

JP Services Now Available

From July 15, my office will offer Justice of the Peace (JP) services.

JPs can witness a person making a statutory declaration, witness a person making an affidavit, and certify that a copy of an original document is a true and accurate copy. Note that if you wish a JP to certify that a copy is a true copy, you **MUST** bring the original document with you for the JP to view, as well as the copy.

In the wild weather just before Christmas and later in March the SES attended over 1,100 calls for assistance when homes were damaged in the hail storm that cut through Casula, Prestons and Moorebank. The SES are always on standby when required and we thank them for their help.

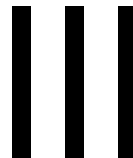
